

Call for nominations for the 2015 IUPAP Magnetism Award and Néel Medal

The IUPAP Magnetism Award and Néel Medal are presented every three years, at the International Conference on Magnetism, to a scientist (or scientists) who has made an outstanding contribution to the field of magnetism.

A prize of \$3,000 is awarded by IUPAP together with the medal.

The award winner will be selected by a committee composed of the members of the IUPAP Magnetism Commission (C9), together with former award winners of the Magnetism Award. Nominations may be made by anyone interested in the field of magnetism.

Current members of the C9 commission are ineligible for nomination.

The nomination papers should include:

- A laudatio of approximately 50 words.
- *Curriculum vitae* of the candidate, which must not exceed *two* pages in length.
- List of 10 of the candidate's most significant publications, including citation information, not to exceed one page.
- Commentary on the publications, which makes the case for the award, not to exceed *two* pages.
- Letters of support, up to a maximum of five pages.

The documents must be collated into a single pdf file called *Surname_manm.pdf*, where *Surname* is the candidate's name. The file must not exceed 2MB in size.

Nominations not conform to these rules cannot be accepted.
