

## **Report from Kennedy Reed on how we may celebrate our Centenary**

My current thoughts about the Centennial are as follows:

1. Since there will not be an IUPAP General Assembly in the Centennial year (2022), maybe we should plan to have a Centennial Symposium during the 2023 General Assembly. (Content TBD). Note that 2013 will be the Centennial of the first IUPAP GA.
2. During the Centennial year, we could post monthly features related to IUPAP history on the IUPAP web site. (eg. We might feature one or more founding member countries each month - with input from the country's liaison committee).
3. Other articles on IUPAP history could be featured in the IUPAP Newsletters during the year 2022. (Maybe with input from the Commissions)
4. We might consider using some of IUPAP's reserve funds to have a high quality IUPAP 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary booklet professionally produced.
